In this particular case, it was not an error on your part since your record indicated that the well was completed in 1941, but this fact was not noted until after permit had been issued to you.

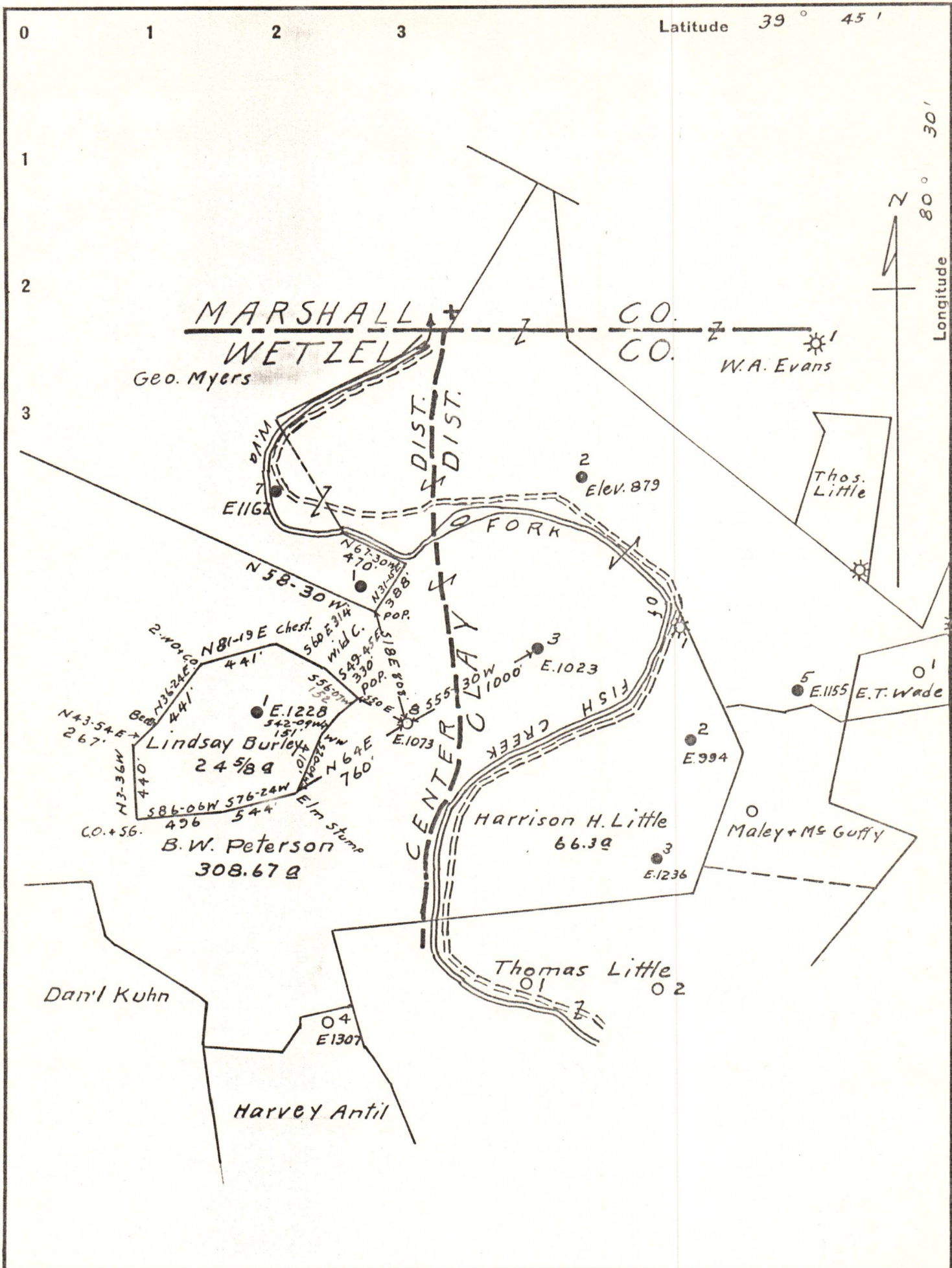
