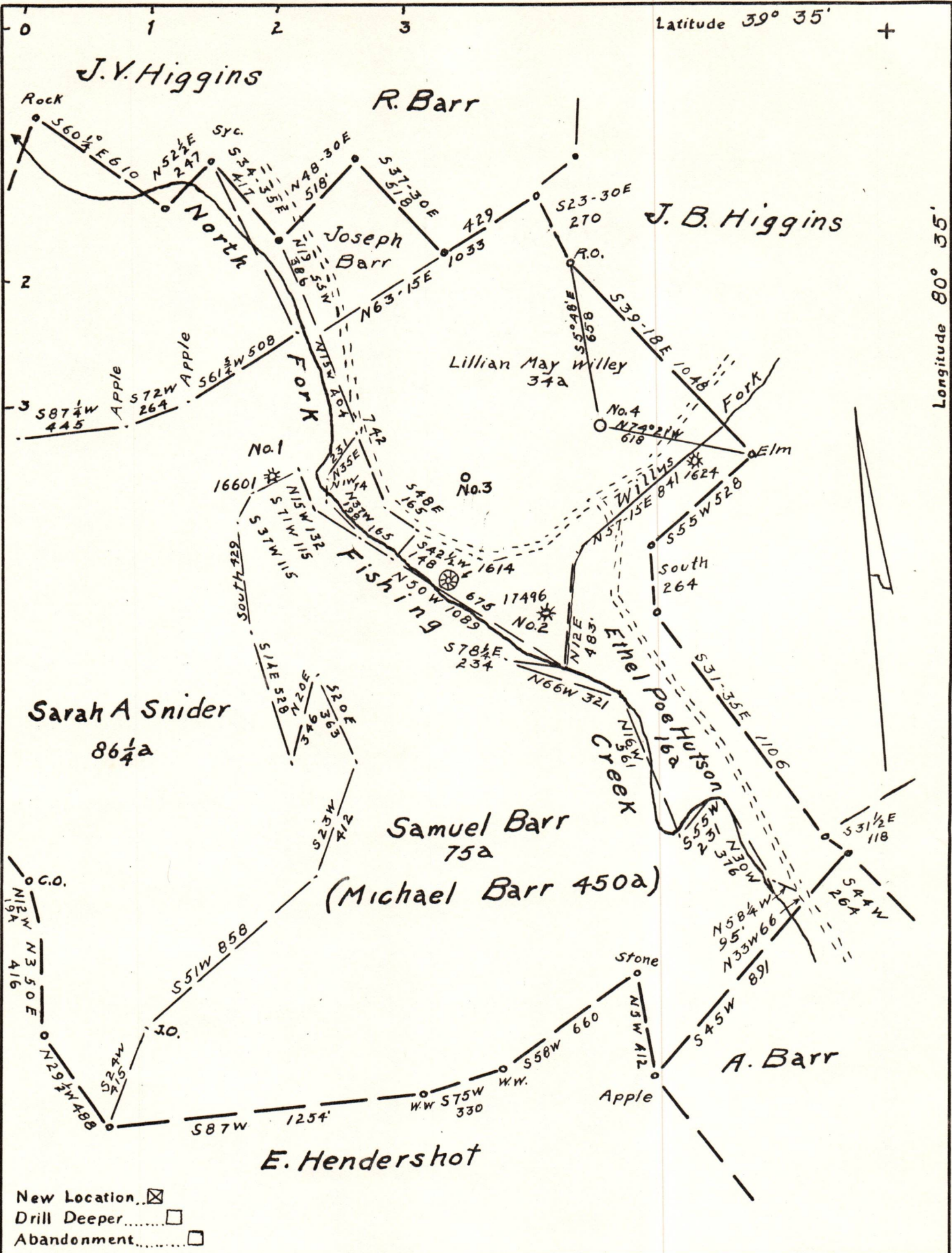
WELL LOCATION MAP

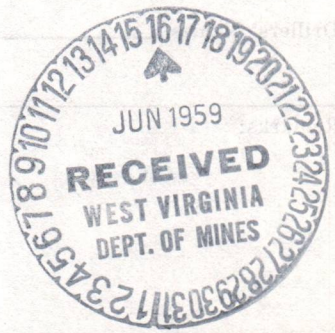
