

COMMENTS, LIENS AND DEFECTS

2. The subject property is owned by Estella Iona Thomas, having been conveyed to her and her now deceased husband, Ross Thomas, Sr., by James M. Skinner and Mary H. Skinner, by a deed dated April 6, 1949, which is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit B. In said deed, reference is made to reservations, exceptions and rights in previous deeds, but none are found in examination of such previous deeds. Another provision of the deed provides free gas for Thomas and compensation for damages resulting from oil and gas drilling operations. It would therefore appear that the parties intended that the oil, gas, and minerals be reserved, or that they thought they had been reserved, when, in fact, no such reservation was made in that deed or in any previous deeds. Further, the parties have executed leases as though Mary H. Skinner, the grantor in the above-mentioned deed, had reserved the oil, gas and minerals. It should be noted that Ross Thomas, Sr. is deceased. Property taxes on the minerals have been paid by the Skinners since 1949, and the Skinners are the only parties who have leased the subject property for oil and gas purposes subsequent to the date of this deed.

The ownership of the oil, gas and minerals was conveyed to Ross Thomas, Sr. and Estella Iona Thomas by the words of the instrument, but by the references to the oil, gas and minerals and the conduct of the parties, it could very well be determined by a court that Mary E. Skinner is entitled to an interest in the oil, gas and minerals.

REQUIREMENT: The ownership of the oil, gas and minerals in and underlying the subject property cannot be determined due to the circumstances set forth hereinabove. You are advised, however, that you may obtain a valid, operative lease covering the subject property by virtue of an assignment of both of the operative leases mentioned hereinabove, since either Mary E. Skinner or Estella Iona Thomas is the legal owner of the oil, gas and minerals. This title examiner recommends that if you desire to operate for oil and gas on the subject property, that any and all royalties to which the legal owner is entitled be deposited with a court of competent jurisdiction in an interpleader or declaratory judgment action, so that said court may determine the rightful owner of the oil, gas and minerals in and underlying the subject property and provide direction with respect to the person or persons to whom royalties should be paid. Such royalties should not be paid directly to either Mary E. Skinner or Estella Iona Thomas, absent a written and recorded agreement between the parties specifying to whom such royalties should be paid, or a court order directing payment.

REQUIREMENT: The ownership of the oil and gas in and underlying the subject real property as it is presently assessed in the Wetzel County Land Books does not correspond with the present status of mineral ownership as set forth hereinabove. This is due to the fact that the tax records do not reflect the conveyance of a 1/4th interest in and to the 182.11 acre tract of land by Frank E. Wells and Ruth K. Wells, husband and wife, as is more fully set forth in attached Exhibit Q. It is the opinion of this title examiner that the distribution of royalty should be made pursuant to the current status of mineral ownership set forth hereinabove. Therefore you must ascertain the exact location of each well drilled upon the subject tract of land to determine whether such well is located on the 182.11 acre parcel or the 233.16 acre parcel. The location of each well will determine how the proceeds from such well should be distributed.
