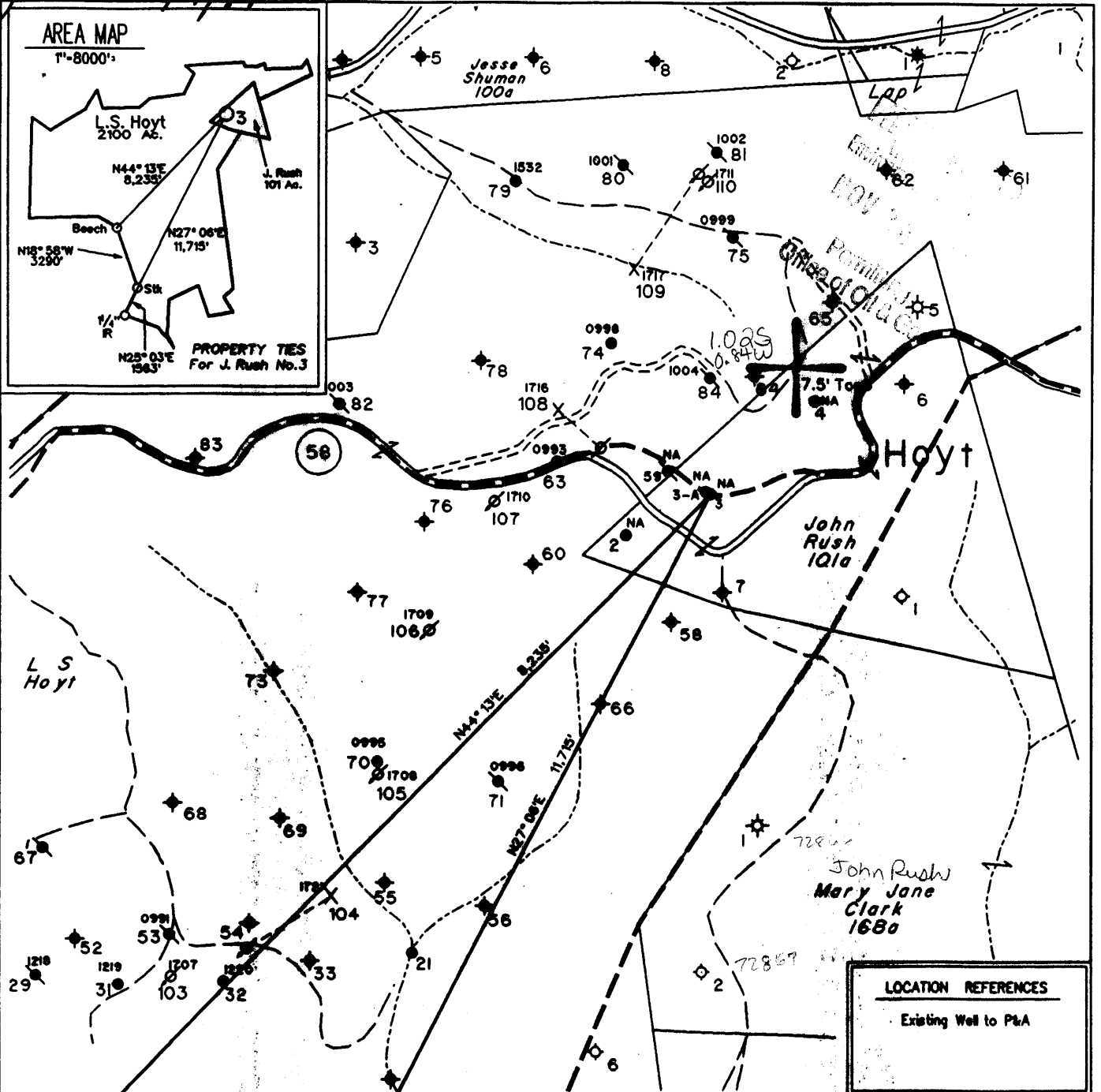
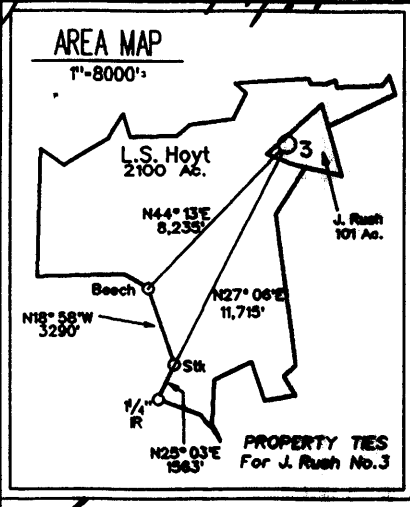

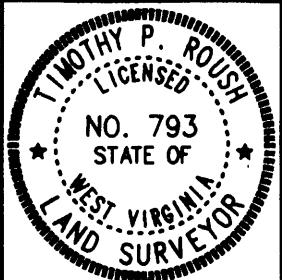

Record preceded by following remarks in Vol. I(a):

"On the high divide between the waters of Big and Little Fishing Creeks, and about four miles northeast from Pine Grove, the greatest thickness of measures above the Pittsburgh Coal, of any well yet reported from the Appalachian field, was found on the land of John H. Rush. The well starts near the summit of a high knob, and the record reads as follows:"

The record was followed by the following on p. 206, Vol. I(a):

"It is practically certain that at no other point in the Appalachian basin could the thickness of strata overlying the Pittsburgh Coal exceed the above by more than 40 to 50 feet, and as the Waynesburg Coal overlies the Pittsburgh bed about 300 feet in the region, this would give 1,100 to 1,150 feet for the maximum thickness of the Permian or Dunkard Series in this county."

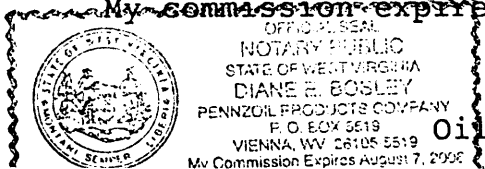
