WELL WORK PERMIT

Horizontal 6A Well

This permit, API Well Number: 47-10302972, issued to EQT PRODUCTION COMPANY, is evidence of permission granted to perform the specified well work at the location described on the attached pages and located on the attached plat, subject to the provisions of Chapter 22 of the West Virginia Code of 1931, as amended, and all rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and to all conditions and provisions outlined in the pages attached hereto. Notification shall be given by the operator to the Oil and Gas Inspector at least 24 hours prior to the construction of roads, locations, and/or pits for any permitted work. In addition, the well operator shall notify the same inspector 24 hours before any actual well work is commenced and prior to running and cementing casing. Spills or emergency discharges must be promptly reported by the operator to 1-800-642-3074 and to the Oil and Gas inspector.

Please be advised that form WR-35, Well Operators Report of Well Work is to be submitted to this office within 90 days completion of permitted well work, as should form WR-34 Discharge Monitoring Report within 30 days of discharge of pits, if applicable. Failure to abide by all statutory and regulatory provisions governing all duties and operations hereunder may result in suspension or revocation of this permit and, in addition, may result in civil and/or criminal penalties being imposed upon the operators.

In addition to the applicable requirements of this permit, and the statutes and rules governing oil and gas activity in WV, this permit may contain specific conditions which must be followed. Permit conditions are attached to this cover letter.

Per 35CSR-4-5.2.g this permit will expire in two (2) years from the issue date unless permitted well work is commenced. If there are any questions, please feel free to contact me at (304) 926-0499 ext. 1654.

PERMIT CONDITIONS

West Virginia Code § 22-6A-8(d) allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. Failure to adhere to the specified permit conditions may result in enforcement action.

CONDITIONS

- 1. This proposed activity may require permit coverage from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACOE). Through this permit, you are hereby being advised to consult with USACOE regarding this proposed activity.
- 2. If the operator encounters an unanticipated void, or an anticipated void at an unanticipated depth, the operator shall notify the inspector within 24 hours. Modifications to the casing program may be necessary to comply with W. Va. Code § 22-6A-5a (12), which requires drilling to a minimum depth of thirty feet below the bottom of the void, and installing a minimum of twenty (20) feet of casing. Under no circumstance should the operator drill more than fifty (50) feet below the bottom of the void or install less than twenty (20) feet of casing below the bottom of the void.
- 3. When compacting fills, each lift before compaction shall not be more than 12 inches in height, and the moisture content of the fill material shall be within limits as determined by the Standard Proctor Density test of the actual soils used in specific engineered fill, ASTM D698, Standard Test Method for Laboratory Compaction Characteristics of Soil Using Standard Effort, to achieve 95 % compaction of the optimum density. Each lift shall be tested for compaction, with a minimum of two tests per lift per acre of fill. All test results shall be maintained on site and available for review.
- 4. Operator shall install signage per § 22-6A-8g (6) (B) at all source water locations included in their approved water management plan within 24 hours of water management plan activation.
- 5. Oil and gas water supply wells will be registered with the Office of Oil and Gas and all such wells will be constructed and plugged in accordance with the standards of the Bureau for Public Health set forth in its Legislative rule entitled *Water Well Regulations*, 64 C.S.R. 19. Operator is to contact the Bureau of Public Health regarding permit requirements. In lieu of plugging, the operator may transfer the well to the surface owner upon agreement of the parties. All drinking water wells within fifteen hundred feet of the water supply well shall be flow tested by the operator upon request of the drinking well owner prior to operating the water supply well.
- 6. Pursuant to the requirements pertaining to the sampling of domestic water supply wells/springs the operator shall, no later than thirty (30) days after receipt of analytical data provide a written copy to the Chief and any of the users who may have requested such analyses.
- 7. If any explosion or other accident causing loss of life or serious personal injury occurs in or about a well or well work on a well, the well operator or its contractor shall give notice, stating the particulars of the explosion or accident, to the oil and gas inspector and the Chief, within 24 hours of said accident.
- 8. During the casing and cementing process, in the event cement does not return to the surface, the oil and gas inspector shall be notified within 24 hours.

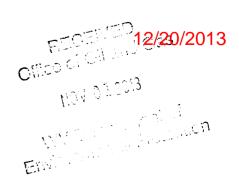

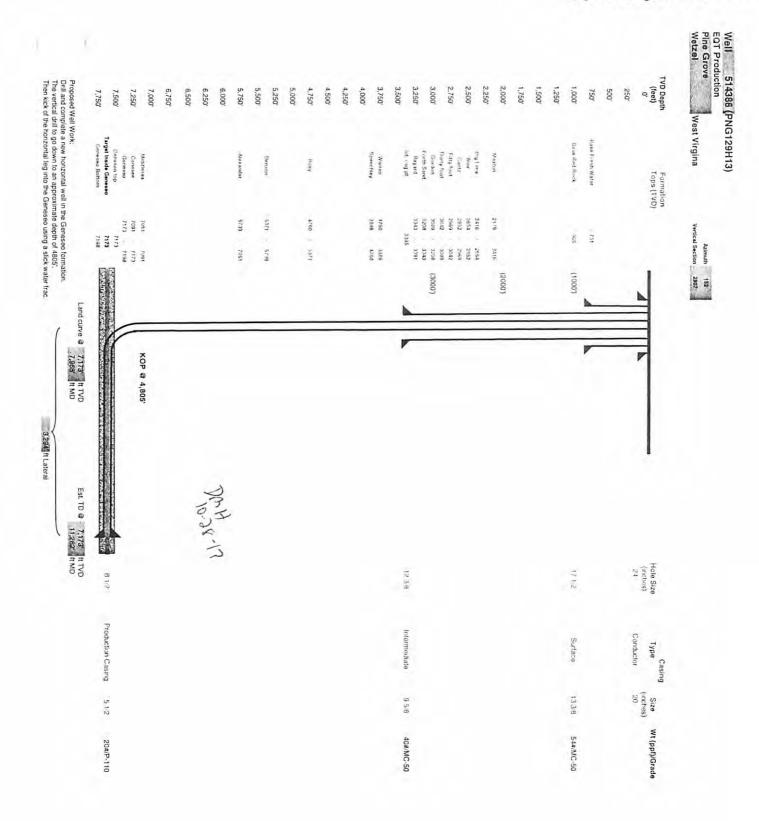

19) Describe proposed well work, including the drilling and plugging back of any pilot hole:
Drill and completa a new horizontal well in the Genesseo formation. The vertical drill to go down to an approximate depth of 4805'
then kick off the horizontal leg into the Genesseo using a slick water frac.
20) Describe fracturing/stimulating methods in detail, including anticipated max pressure and max rate:
tydrautic tracturing is completed in accordance with state regulations using water recycled from previously fractured wells and obtained from reshwater sources. This water is mixed with sand and a small percentage (less than 0.3%) of chemicals (including 15% Hydrochloric acid,
relling agent, gel breaker, friction reducer, blockle, and scale inhibitor), referred to in the industry as a "slickwater" completion. Maximum

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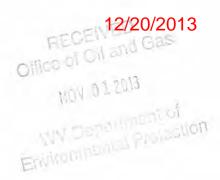

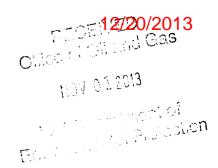

Important:

For each proposed primary water source (including source intakes for purchased water sources) identified in your water management plan, and summarized herein, DEP has made an evaluation concerning water availability over the specified date range. DEP's assessment is based on the following considerations:

- •Statistical analysis of historical USGS stream gauge data (transferred to un-gauged locations as necessary);
- •Identification of sensitive aquatic life (endangered species, mussels, etc.);
- •Quantification of known existing demands on the water supply (Large Quantity Users);
- •Minimum flows required by the Army Corps of Engineers; and
- Designated stream uses.

Based on these factors, DEP has provided, for each intake location (and origination point for purchased water), a reference gauge location and discharge flow reading which must be surpassed prior to withdrawals. Additionally, DEP has established a minimum passby flow at the withdrawal location which must also be surpassed prior to withdrawals. These thresholds are considered terms of the permit and are enforceable as such.

DEP is aware that some intake points will be used for mutiple wells and well sites. In these cases, the thresholds set by the Water Management Plan are to be interepreted as total withdrawal limits for each location over the specified date range regardless of how many wells are supported by that intake.

For all purchased water intakes, determinations of water availability are made at the original source intake location. It is the responsibility of the Oil and Gas Operator, not the seller, to cease withdrawal of water from the seller when flows are less than the minimum gauge reading at the stream gauge referenced by the Water Management Plan in order to protect stream uses.

Note that the determinations made herein are based on the best available data, but it is impossible to predict water availability in the future. While the DEP has carefully established these minimum withdrawal thresholds, it remains the operator's responsibility to protect aquatic life at all times. Approval to withdrawal is contingent upon permission from the land owner. It is the responsibility of the operator to secure and maintain permission prior to any withdrawals.

The operator is reminded that 24-48 hours prior to withdrawing (or purchasing) water, DEP must be notified by email at DEP.water.use@wv.gov.
