Letter 3-18-04: Put in 118 feet liner in single sections. Rests on bottom when well is cleaned.

14" conductor; 10" casing, 324' (pulled); 8 1/2", 1673'; 6-5/8", 2255'.

Well was shot Mar. 11, 1904, by C. C. Fisher, with 60 qts., two shells in 1st and 2nd pays. 2nd pay, 1st shell, 30 qts., 6' shell;

4' anchor; depth of well when shot, 2435'; depth, top of shot, 2425'; 1st pay, 2nd shell, 30 qts., 6' shell; 3' anchor; depth of well when shot, 2425'; depth, top of shot, 2416'.
