Filled up 200 ft. on first bit 2nd pay; 1600 ft. first 24 hrs.

First hole: buried 1 complete string of tools.

Second hole: buried 1 complete string of tools.

Third hole: buried 1 complete string of tools and bailer, also 60 ft. 8 1/2" casing.

6-5/8" hole reduced to 6" at 2431'.

From bottom of 6-5/8" casing to top of Maxton Sand, 161 ft.

165 ft. 5-3/16" liner set on top of Maxton Sand at 2431'.

1 1/2" conductor; 10" casing, 337' (37' pulled); 8 1/2" casing, 1700' (pulled); 6-5/8", 2268'.

Shot Dec. 19, 1904, by Fisher Torpedo Co., with 80 qts.; 20' shell; 10' anchor; depth of well when shot, 2475'; depth top of shot, 2445'; bridged.

Shot Dec. 19, 1905, by Fisher Torpedo Co., with 80 qts.; 19' shell; 21' anchor; depth of well when shot, 2485'; depth top of shot, 2450'; bridged at 1200'.

Shot June 24, 1924, by Young Torpedo Co., 100 lb. Nitro gela. and 80 qts.; shells passed; depth of well when shot, 2461';

2 - 5" x 6" shells, with nitro gela. 100 lbs.;

4 - 4 1/2" x 6" shells, with 80 qts.; all shells fell over.
