Conductor, 10"; 10" casing, 580'; 8 1/4", 1075'; 6-5/8", 1560';
5-3/16", 1985'; 4" liner, 535', in two sections; 271' in
first, and 252' in second; bottom joint perforated.

Filled up 800' with oil and water from Injun pay. Filled up
1200' with oil from Bayard Sand, the first 12 hours; no gas &
all. Bottom hole packer put in with 5-3/16" casing.

Shot March 26, 1904, by C. C. Fisher, with 24 qts. dynamite;
depth before being shot, 2981'; after, 2997'.

"These Bayard Sand wells are generally cased deep into the Big
Injun Sand so as to shut off any water there, and then about 500'
of 4" liner is set on top of the sand to shut off the caving
shales of the Venango beds above." (Note by I.C.W.)
