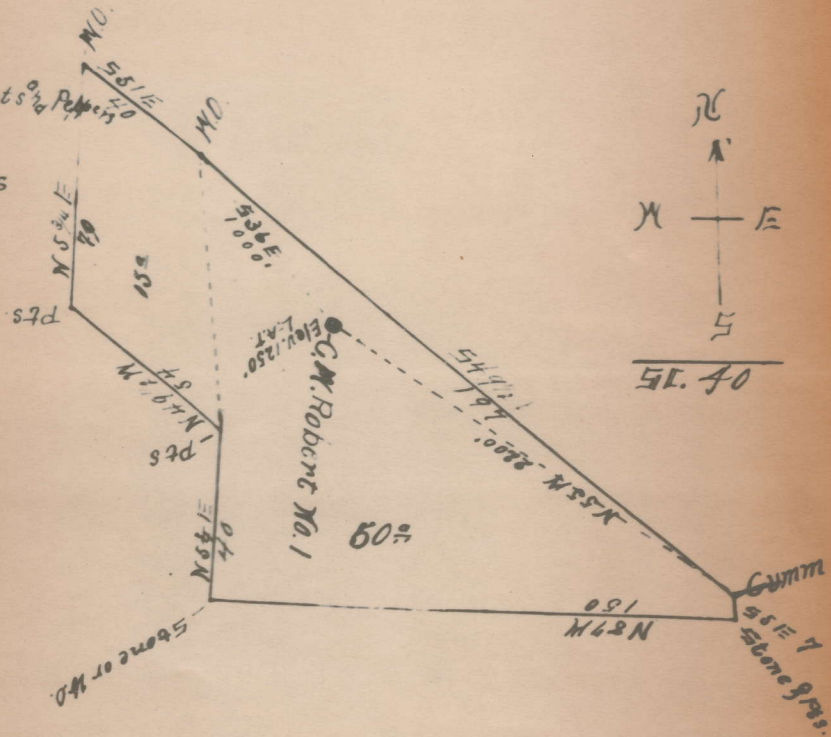


Plat of the Proposed Location of Well No 1 of the

and filling oil and gas wells and were employed by Jesse Mason & J.B. Snider, well operator, and participated in the work of plugging and filling the above well, that said work was commenced on the

27 day of April, 1931, and that the well was plugged and filled in the following manner:

Manner in which sand was plugged:

This was a Salt sand well we drilled through with a 8 1/4 hole and 6 5/8 casing hung on huck wall packer near 1400 ft and we drove a wood plug in the bottom of the 6 5/8 casing and run a cement plug on top of wood plug. then cut casing above and pulled same. then bridged hole at 280 ft and filled to surface with mud sand set cement minimum 7 in square 18 in a beve ground.

Manner in which coal was plugged:

there is no coal
I had a talk with Mr Brown in regard as to the condetien of this well and we both decided this was as good as could be did with this well under the condition the well was in.

Description of monument:

Cement 7 in square 18 in high with Jesse Mason & J.B. Snider on same

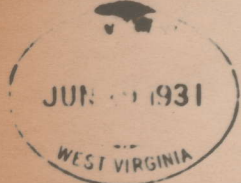
Gentlemen:—
