WORK ORDER

Well to be plugged and filled as follows:

WORK ORDER SUPPLIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Bottom of hole 2190'

Fill with red clay from the bottom 2190' to 2160' - 20' above the Berea Sand.
Drive wood plug from 2160' to 2157'
Cement from 2157' to 2147' sealing the Berea Sand.

Continue to fill with red clay from 2147' to 1750' - 5' below the 5-3/16" casing
Drive wood plug from 1750' to 1747'
PULL 1745' of 5-3/16" casing

Continue to fill with red clay from 1747' to 1510' - 20' above the Salt Sand.
Drive wood plug from 1510' to 1507'
Cement from 1507' to 1497' sealing off Salt Water.

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1134' - 30' below the Gas Sand.
Fill with red clay from 1134' to 874' - 10' below the 6-5/8" casing
Drive wood plug from 874' to 871'
Cement from 871' to 864'

PULL 6-5/8" casing set at 864'

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 510' - 30' below the 8-1/4" casing
1 sack of cement (mixed with water only) on top of bridge
Fill with clay from 510' to 480'

PULL 8-1/4" casing set at 480' and
Continue to fill with red clay to the surface
