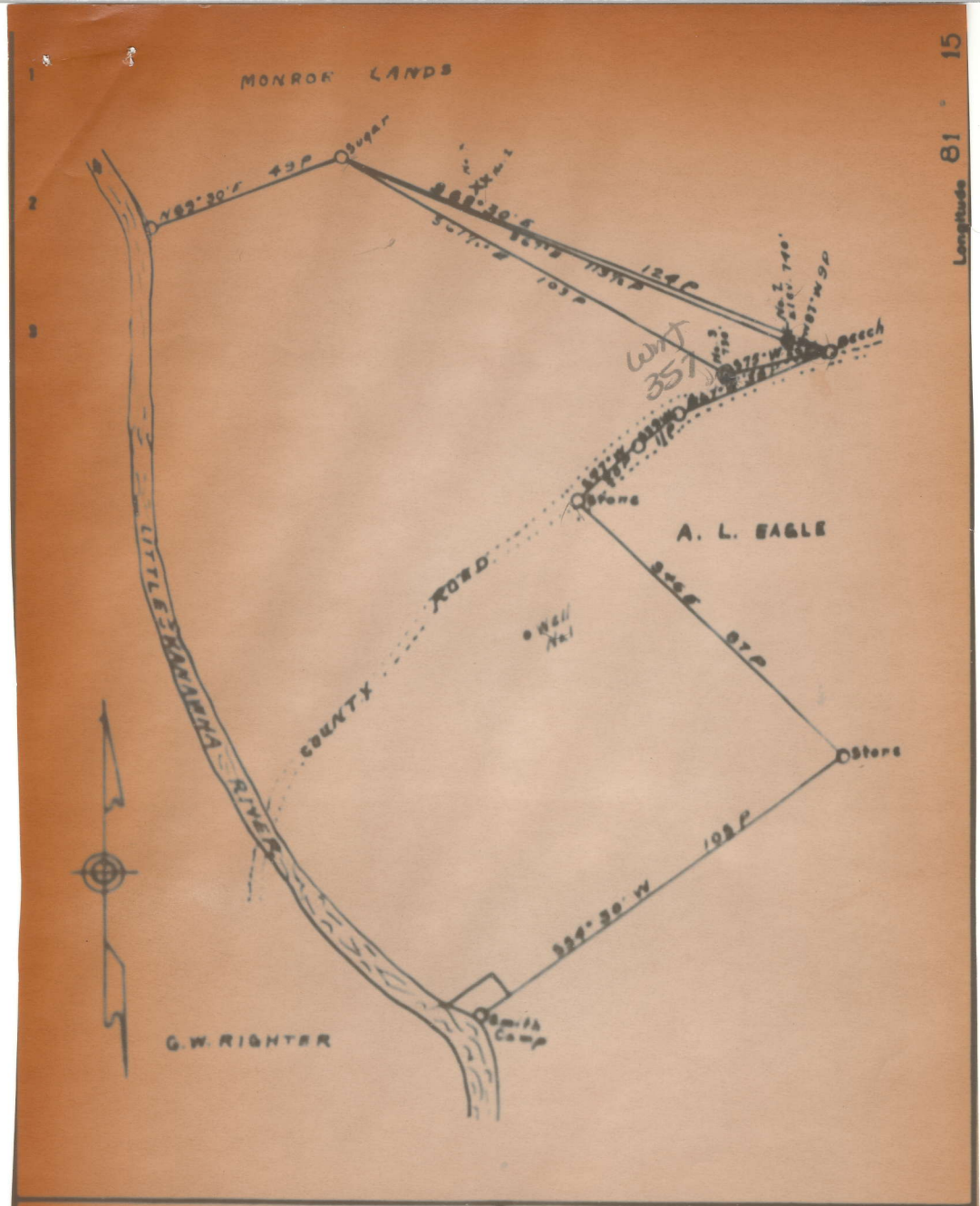

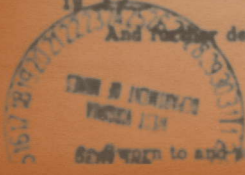

WORK ORDER ARRANGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MINES:

Approximate total depth - 1000'

Fill with red clay from bottom 1000' to 900' - top of Salt Sand

Wood plug 900 - 897'

Cement 897 - 887' - sealing the Salt Sands above

Continue to fill with red clay from 887 to 500' - top of H. Dunkard Sand.

Wood plug 500 - 497'

Cement 497 - 487' - sealing hole above the H. Dunkard

Continue to fill with red clay from 487' to the surface

Erect marker such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations.
