Set permant bridge at 1015'--25 feet below sand at 960±990'

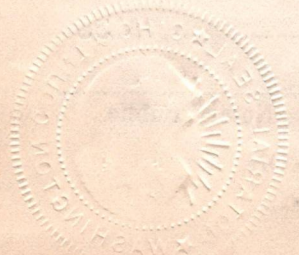
