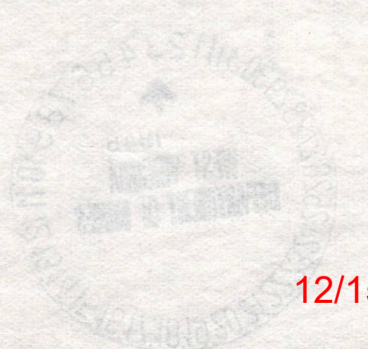

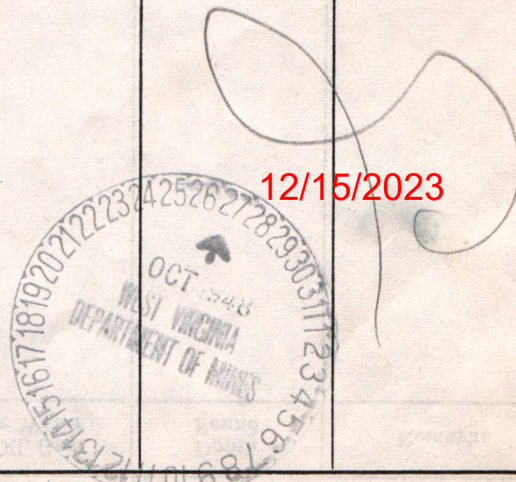

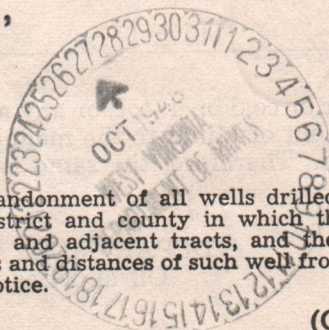

Fill with red clay from bottom 2005' - 1900' - 54' above Berea Sand

Neat Cement 1900' - 1890'

5' crushed stone on cement plug

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 1550' - 44' below 5-3/16" casing

2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge

As- Pull 5-3/16" casing and

Fill with clay to 1150'

Neat Cement 1150' - 1140'

5' crushed stone on cement plug - sealing off all salt water

Pull 6-5/8" ~~submergible~~ casing

SET A PERMANENT BRIDGE AT 600' as 8-1/4" casing is pulled

2 sacks neat cement and 5' crushed stone on bridge

Fill with clay to surface - pulling 127' of 10" casing

Hole may be filled with red clay from 1140' to 260' - set plug at 260' for fresh water protection

Fill with clay to surface

Erect marker such as is described in Rule 18, 1931 Regulations

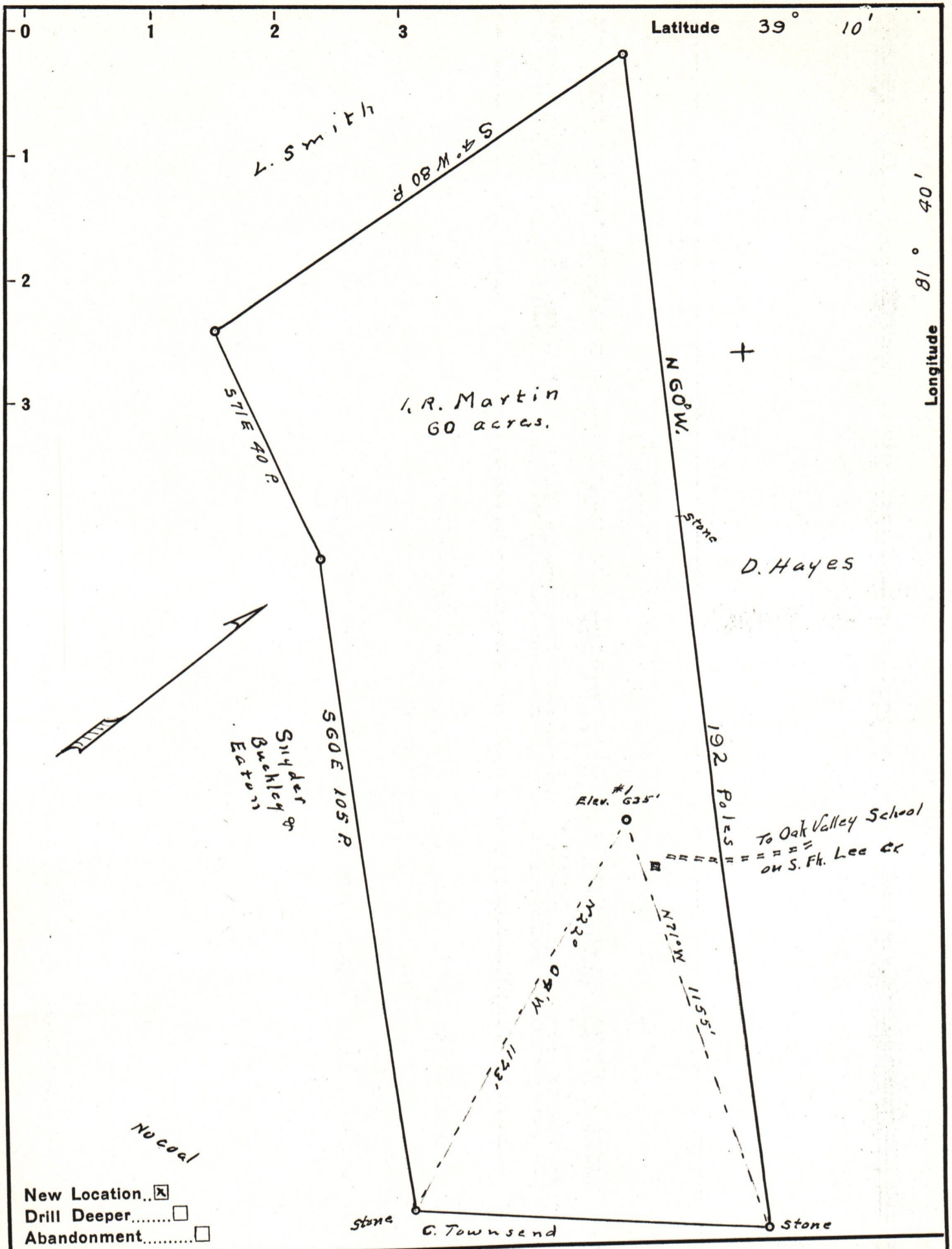
