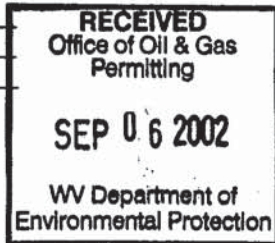

4. Gel hole
5. Cement 500 ft. to 400 ft.
6. Pull 2 3/8 tubing.
7. Free point, and cut 5 1/2 casing at @ 200 ft.
8. Pull 5 1/2 casing.
9. Run 2 3/8 tubing to 250 ft.
10. Cement 250 ft. to surface.
11. Erect monument. With API
