PERMIT CONDITIONS

West Virginia Code § 22-6-11 allows the Office of Oil and Gas to place specific conditions upon this permit. Permit conditions have the same effect as law. Failure to adhere to the specified permit conditions may result in enforcement action.

CONDITIONS

- 1. If the operator encounters an unanticipated void, or an anticipated void at an unanticipated depth, the operator shall notify the inspector within 24 hours. Modifications to the casing program may be necessary to comply with W. Va. Code § 22-6-20, which requires drilling to a minimum depth of thirty feet below the bottom of the void, and installing a minimum of twenty (20) feet of casing. Under no circumstance should the operator drill more than fifty (50) feet below the bottom of the void or install less than twenty (20) feet of casing below the bottom of the void.
- 2. Pursuant to 35 CSR § 4-19.1.a, at the request of the surface owner all water wells or springs within 1000 feet of the proposed well that are actually utilized for human consumption, domestic animals or other general use shall be sampled and analyzed.
- 3. Pursuant to 35 CSR § 4-19.1.c, if the operator is unable to sample and analyze any water well or spring within one thousand (1,000) feet of the permitted well location, the Office of Oil and Gas requires the operator to sample, at a minimum, one water well or spring located between one thousand (1,000) feet and two thousand (2,000) feet of the permitted well location.
- 4. All pits must be lined with a minimum of 20 mil thickness synthetic liner.
- 5. In the event of an accident or explosion causing loss of life or serious personal injury in or about the well or while working on the well, the well operator or its contractor shall give notice, stating the particulars of the accident or explosion, to the oil and gas inspector and the Chief within twenty-four (24) hours.
- 6. During the surface casing and cementing process, in the event cement does not return to the surface, or any other casing string that is permitted to circulate cement to the surface and does not return to the surface, the oil and gas inspector shall be notified within twenty-four (24) hours.
- 7. Well work activities shall not constitute a hazard to the safety of persons.

Please find enclosed, documentation concerning the modification of the existing new well permits for CBM Well 9K-A (API#: 47-109-03118) and CBM Well 9K-B (API#: 47-109-03117). This modification is for additional horizontal drilling of the Pocahontas No. 2 coal seam in conjunction with the currently permitted horizontal drilling of the Pocahontas No. 3 coal seam from the articulated CBM Well 9K-A with both boreholes intercepting the vertical CBM Well 9K-B located to the West. The drilling plan for the Pocahontas No. 2 seam is underlain to match the approved Pocahontas No. 3 seam with a fifty (50) foot offset to the side of the approved drilling plan. It is anticipated that the Pocahontas No. 2 coal seam will be consistently 15 to 20 feet below the Pocahontas No. 3 coal seam with an average thickness of 1.15 feet for the area of this modification. This modification also includes a change in the casing schedule for 9K-B (47-109-03117) for the purpose of converting the CBM Well to a Gob Well post mining of the Pocahontas No. 3 coal seam. 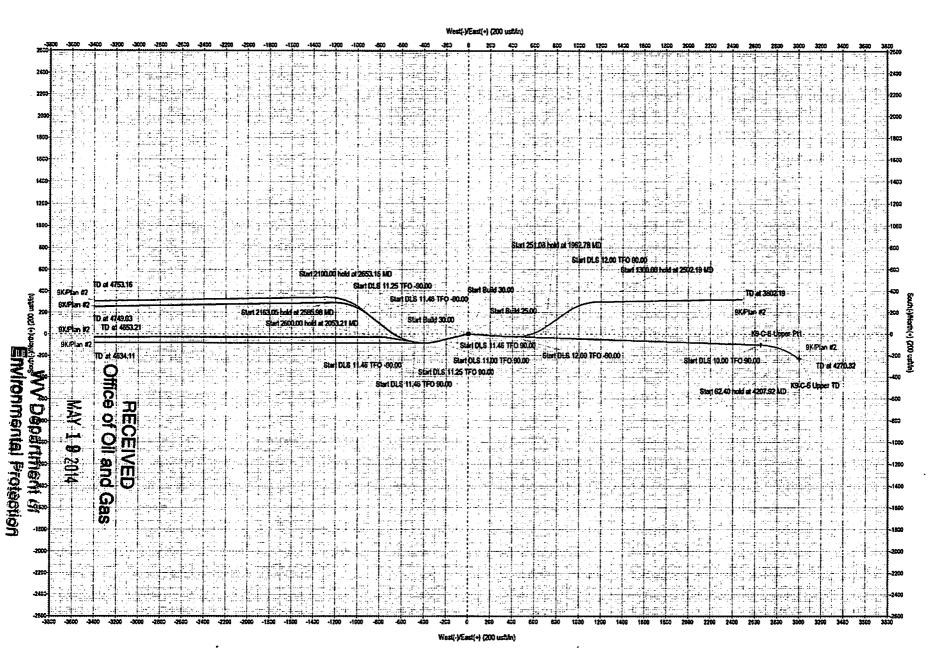

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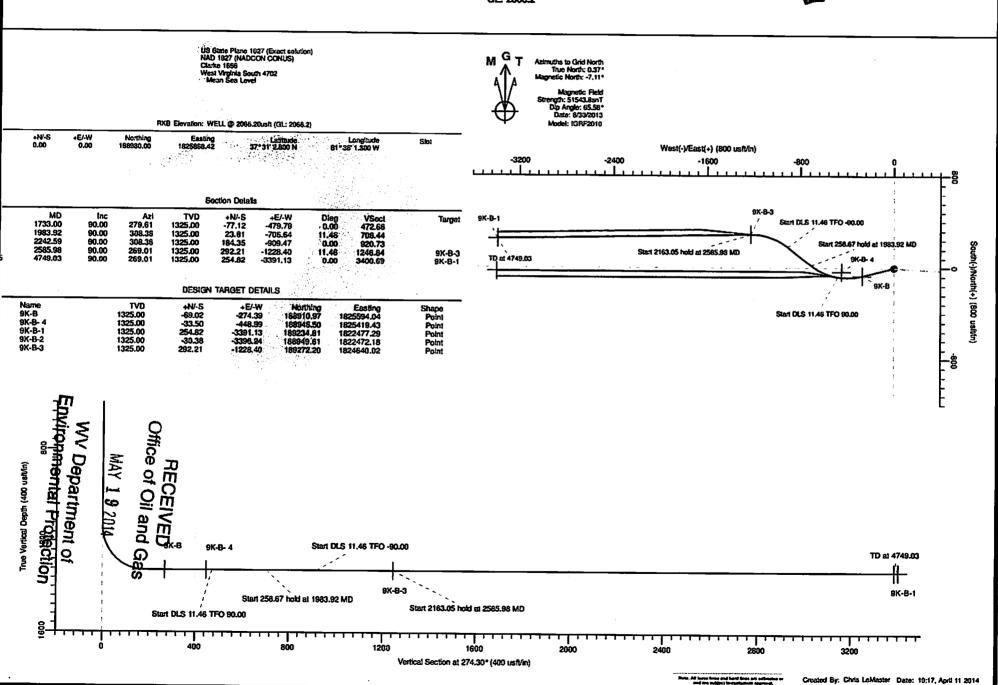
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Ultra Pipeline Wyoming County, WV 9-K 9K-B-1 Plan #2 GL: 2066.2





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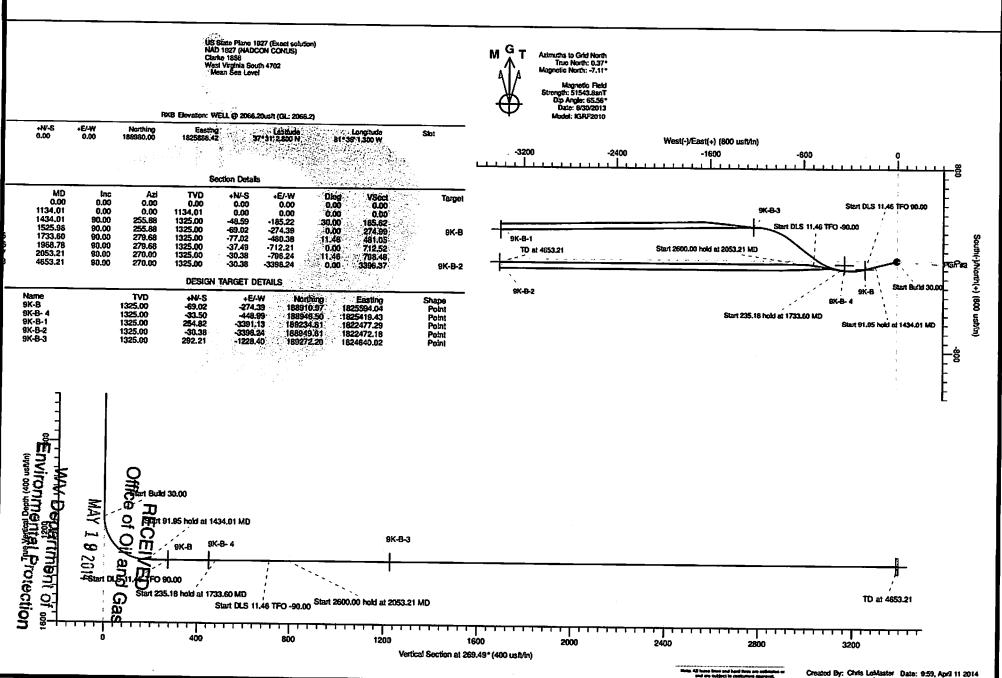

Time limits and methods for filing comments. The law provides that certain parties are to receive copies of an application for a coalbed methane well permit prior to the filing of the application. You have FIFTEEN (15) DAYS after the filing date to file your comments. Comments must be filed in person or received in the mail by the Office of Oil and Gas within that time. You may call the Office to be sure of the date. Check with your postmaster to ensure adequate delivery time or to arrange special expedited handling.

Comments must be in writing. Your comments must include your name, address, and telephone number (if you have a telephone), the well operator's name and well number, and the approximate location of the proposed well site, including district and county from the application. You may add other documents, such as sketches, maps or photographs to support your comments.

List of Water Testing Laboratories. The Office of Oil and Gas maintains a list of water testing laboratories which you can hire to test your water to establish water quality prior to and after drilling. Contact the Office to obtain a copy.

Permits. Permits for coalbed methane wells may be granted or derived as provided in Article 21 of Chapter 22 of the West Virginia Code. The Chief of the Office of Oil and Gas has the power to deny or condition a well work permit based on comments on the following grounds:

- The proposed well work will constitute a hazard to the safety of persons; 1)
- The soil erosion and sediment control plan is not adequate or effective; 2)
- Damage would occur to publicly owned lands or resources; 3)
- The proposed well work fails to protect fresh water sources or supplies; or 4)
- The Applicant has committed a substantial violation of a previous permit or a 5) substantial violation of one or more of the rules promulgated under Chapter 22, and has failed to abate or seek review of the violation. You may request additional information and/or request notice of the permit decision from the Chief.
