



Figure Dbs-8. Stratigraphic cross section A-A' of the Bradford play in Pennsylvania prepared by Flaherty (1994). Based on a network of similar cross sections, Flaherty interpreted two primary transgressive-regressive cycles within the Bradford play, which he named the Bradford cycle (intervals B-1 and B-2) and the Speechley cycle (intervals B-3, B-4, and B-5). Smallest-scale cycles are considered to be sixth order. Figure modified slightly to show atlas intervals. Location of north-south cross section (Figure Dbs-9) is also shown.
