The upper part of the Lockport interval also includes the Salina "A" and "B" at the top. Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation No. 8804 Fee (Kanawha 1684) is the designated discovery well for Indian Creek field. The two westernmost wells (Jackson 1246 and Jackson 1231) are outside the play boundary and fall within the Lower Silurian Cataract/Medina Group ("Clinton") sandstone play (see M. McCormac and others, this atlas).**
