1850 1869 19

Sandstone, yellowish gray, very fine to medium grained, rounded to well rounded, highly dolomitic

Pocono Formation 66⁺ Feet.

1869 1886 17

Sandstone, very light gray, fine grained, sub-angular, contains many very fine grains

1886 1906 20

Sandstone, very light to light gray, fine to fine grained, argillaceous, silty

1906 1912 6

Shale, dark gray, very silty

1912 1929 17

Sandstone, very light to light gray, ^{very} fine grained, silty, very silty at the top, ^{very} argillaceous

1929 1935 6

Shale, dark gray, some dark yellowish brown, (highly sideritic)
