Located 1.06 mi. S. of 39°15' and 4.43 mi. W. of 81°20' - NC - Elizabeth Quadrangle.

Elevation, 373.65' L.

Permit Woo-113

Drilling commenced Aug. 17, 1942; completed Sept. 13, 1942.

Shot Sept. 19, 1942, depth 2280-2290'.

Oil well; 1 bbl. per week after shot.

Samples from 1853 to 2293' examined by J. H. C. Martens. The samples apparently start below the base of the Greenbrier Limestone, if this formation is present at the locality of the well.
